SENATE BILL NO. 2094

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT REFUGEES PLACED IN THIS STATE BY THE
FEDERAL GOVERNMENT MUST REGISTER WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
SERVICES; TO PROVIDE CIVIL LIABILITY FOR VOLUNTARY RESETTLEMENT
ORGANIZATIONS ARISING FROM THE ACTIONS OF A REFUGEE PLACED IN THIS
STATE TO WHOM THE ORGANIZATION PROVIDED SPONSORSHIP OR
RESETTLEMENT SERVICES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** (1) Sponsors placing refugees in this state
- 9 pursuant to the federal Refugee Resettlement Program are required
- 10 to enroll the refugee with the Department of Human Services within
- 11 thirty (30) days of the refugee entering the state. The
- 12 department shall send the enrollment information of refugees
- 13 placed in this state to the Mississippi Department of Public
- 14 Safety.
- 15 (2) In order to register with the department, the sponsor
- 16 shall provide the refugee's name, address, telephone number, job
- 17 status, name and contact information of the refugee's employer, if
- 18 any, all state, local, or federal assistance provided to the
- 19 refugee, criminal record, and any other information that the

20 department determines to be relevant. A sponsor must update the

- 21 refugee's registration within ten (10) days of any change in any
- 22 of the information required for registration.
- 23 (3) The registration information required in subsection (2)
- 24 of this section shall be maintained by the department on a
- 25 database and that database shall not be made available to the
- 26 public.
- 27 **SECTION 2.** (1) A refugee's sponsor shall be strictly liable
- 28 to a person if:
- 29 (a) The refugee is in the Refugee Resettlement Program;
- 30 and
- 31 (b) The refugee acted in a reckless, willful, or
- 32 grossly negligent manner, committed an act of terrorism or
- 33 committed a violent crime, as defined in Section 97-3-2, that
- 34 resulted in physical harm or injury to a person or damage to or
- 35 theft of real or personal property.
- 36 (2) If the conditions of this section are met, the refugee's
- 37 sponsor shall be strictly liable to the injured party. The
- 38 injured party shall be entitled to recover damages in a civil
- 39 action.
- 40 **SECTION 3.** The Mississippi Department of Public Safety, in
- 41 conjunction with local law enforcement agencies, shall confirm
- 42 that any refugees placed in Mississippi by the federal government
- 43 pursuant to the Refugee Resettlement Program do not pose a public
- 44 safety risk. The Mississippi Department of Public Safety must
- 45 report to the Legislature its findings regarding public safety

- 46 risks as soon as practicable and thereafter update the report not
- 47 later than December 1st of each year.
- 48 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 49 and after July 1, 2019.
